COMPLETION

SUCCESS IS DEFINED AS:

- Completing lesson coursework, exhibiting mastery in all concepts.
- Achieving an 80% score on all lesson quizzes.
- Achieving a 90% score on all lesson tests.
- Completing a minimum of 185 student-teaching field hours under the supervision of a qualifying, veteran, mentor teacher.
- Passing required Florida State Exams, demonstrating General Knowledge, Subject Area Knowledge, and Professional Educator Knowledge.
- Receipt of Florida Department of Education Statement of Eligibility verifying eligibility requirements.
- Exhibiting standards of behavior expected of professionals in an education environment.



QUALITY INDICATORS

UNIVERSITY AFFILIATION:

Teacher Ready is a graduate-level Educator Preparation Institute (EPI) for the University of West Florida Professional Education Unit.

ACCREDITATION:

The Professional Education Unit at the University of West Florida is currently accredited by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE). This accreditation covers initial teacher preparation programs (traditional and alternative) and advanced educator preparation programs at the Pensacola and online campuses.

July 1, 2013 was the day of the de facto consolidation of NCATE and the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC), making the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) the new, sole specialized accreditor for educator preparation. In preparation for UWF's upcoming accreditation visit in 2017 the Professional Education Unit is currently aligning the educator preparation programs to the new CAEP standards of educator preparation.

FLORIDA STATE APPROVED:

Students who successfully complete the program are eligible for a Florida Professional Teaching Certificate.*

* Students who are not U.S. Citizens are required to hold a teaching job in Florida to be eligible for a Florida Professional Teacher Certificate.
